Interdisciplinarity in research – Winter Camp at NCU is a 1-week Winter school for foreign students and foreign PhD students conducted in English in the form of **ONLINE** learning, with participants divided into 3 groups in terms of participation in specialist modules and a joint cultural program.

ONLINE formula

2) cultural module classes <i>Selected aspects of Polish culture</i>	10 academic hrs
3) <i>Poland as a country of attractive educational opportunities</i>	6 academic hrs

3 specialist modules to choose from

Candidates are enrolled in one of the three specialist modules related to their interests and field of study:

- **HUMANITIES** (e.g. for students of History, Conservation of Monuments, History of Art, Theology, Cultural Studies, Fine Arts, Philology)

Every participant takes part in **one** of the three modules – academic classes conducted by specialists in a given field.

ECTS points and certificate
